DAILY ITINERARY

Thursday, Sep 4- Departure for Dublin

This will be our departure day from the US. Please review flight information:

Depart US on Thursday, Sep 4, Arriving into Dublin (DUB) on Friday, Sep 5
Depart Shannon (SNN) on Sunday, Sep 14**

Friday, Sep 5 - Arrival into Dublin, Welcome Dinner

Upon arrival at Dublin airport, please taxi to the College Green Hotel and check into your centrally located hotel. The rest of the day is free for you to rest, relax and enjoy Dublin's Fair City. This evening we will meet at 7:00 PM for an included welcome dinner at the hotel.

Saturday, Sep 6- Dublin Walking Tour

This morning, we will have a walking tour of Dublin city. Our tour will focus on the highlights of the city center and give an informed and fun perspective of life and history in Ireland's capital. You can see the Georgian doors of Dublin and some of the most interesting buildings in the city.

The walking tour will end at Trinity College Library where included are entrance fees to see the famous Book of Kells. Welcome to the Old Library and the Book of Kells - a "must see" on the itinerary of all visitors to Dublin. The Book of Kells is a 9th-century gospel manuscript famous throughout the world.

The rest of the afternoon and evening are free to explore on your own.





Sunday, Sep 7- Wicklow Mountains, Powerscourt House and Gardens, Glendalough

Today's touring includes Powerscourt House & Gardens, Glendalough and Vale of Avoca. One of the most scenic spots in County Wicklow is the Vale of Avoca, a darkly wooded valley that begins where the Rivers Avonbeg and Avonmore come together to form the River Avoca.



Powerscourt House, a 68-room mansion, was completed in 1741. The mansion was designed around the medieval castle in the style of Palladian architecture and features baroque dome-roofed towers on either side, giving it in the words of one architectural historian, "The massive dignity of a great Italian Renaissance villa."

Glendalough is a remarkable place! The Glendalough Valley is located in the Wicklow Mountains National Park and has many attractions to entice and entertain.

Monday, Sep 8- Kilkenny, Rock of Cashel, Kinsale

We depart Dublin this morning and our first stop will be in Kilkenny which is Ireland's most authentic medieval town for a walking tour.

Then we visit the Rock of Cashel- the site where St Patrick chose to make the head of his church in Ireland. The Rock of Cashel is a spectacular group of medieval buildings set on an outcrop of limestone in the Golden Vale including the 12th century round tower, High Cross and Romanesque Chapel, 13th century Gothic cathedral, 15th century Castle and the restored Hall of the Vicars Choral.

We will arrive into Kinsale later in the afternoon for a two night stay. Kinsale is a colorful, historic harbor town that offers fantastic shopping and restaurants- a "foodie town"- so it will make a great home base for us.



Tuesday, Sep 9- Exploring Cork

After breakfast we will explore Kinsale, enjoy some time in Cork City and the English market where we include a food tasting tour. Then we travel to the town of Cobh to include a visit to the Queenstown Story. Here we will learn about the tragedy of the Irish Famine and the story of Irish Emigration. We will also learn through story boards about the sinking of the US ship Lusitania and the last stop of the ill-fated Titanic at the port of Cobh. Afterwards, we return to Kinsale for an evening at leisure.



Wednesday, Sep 10- Ring of Kerry, Killarney

This morning we travel via West Cork into Kerry where we will tour the most scenic section of the Ring of Kerry. In the late afternoon, we arrive to the popular town of Killarney and check into our hotel. The evening is free to enjoy one of Ireland's most famous tourist towns.

Thursday, Sep 11- Gap of Dunloe, Celtic Steps Show with Dinner

The Gap is a narrow mountain pass between the Mac Gillycuddy Reeks (to the west) and the Purple Mountain (to the east). En-route you pass five lakes linked together by the river Loe, with spectacular mountains on either side. Afterwards, the boatmen will call guests to the boats for departure through three lakes and two rivers to Ross Castle, enjoying beautiful scenery along the way- the majestic oak woods of Derrycunihy and Tomies mountains, the Meeting of the Waters where the three lakes meet, the "shooting of the rapids" (water levels permitting) under the Old Weir Bridge, Dinis Cottage on Dinis Island, the old Copper Mines, where copper was mined in Killarney three thousand years ago.

Tonight we will enjoy a pre show dinner and the Celtic Steps Show that features the popular Irish dance with the authenticity of traditional Irish music.



Friday, Sep 12- Dingle Peninsula

We will depart Killarney this morning for a stop along the Dingle Peninsula.

The Dingle Peninsula -immortalized by the 1970 movie, *Ryan's Daughter*, is one of the most beautiful peninsulas on the Irish coastline. It thrusts out into the Atlantic Ocean to claim Ireland's most westerly point. Dingle is the chief town of the peninsula and is a thriving, colorful fishing port.



In the late afternoon, we arrive at Dromoland Castle where a horse and hound welcome await us at the gates of the Castle. Check in for an evening at your leisure.

Saturday, Sep 13- Cliffs of Moher, Caherconnell Fort, Farewell Dinner at Dromoland Castle

We will depart our castle resort this morning for a memorable final touring day featuring the Cliffs of Moher- a sheer precipice that stretches for 5 miles along the Wild Atlantic Way. Then we're off to see a sheepdog demonstration at the Caherconnell Fort- you will be amazed. Tonight will enjoy our gala farewell dinner in a private room in the castle.



Sunday, Sep 14- Departure from Shannon Airport

It will be time today to say good bye and return home. Please make sure your return flight is from the Shannon Airport (SNN) which is approximately 10 miles from the hotel. A taxi can be arranged for individual departures - to be paid on spot.

Cancellation and Refund Policy

*Cancellations before 180 days of departure date: \$800 deposit retained by Take Me to Europe

*Cancellations from 179 - 120 days of departure date: 25% of package rate retained by Take Me to Europe

*Cancellations from 119 - 60 days before departure date: 50% of package rate retained by Take Me to Europe

*Cancellations from 59 days before departure date or no-show: 100% of package rate retained by Take Me to Europe.

Take Me to Europe, LLC will not be liable regarding provision of medical care or the adequacy of any care rendered. It is understood that Take Me to Europe, LLC will use its best efforts to ensure that adequate measures are taken.

Please note that handicapped facilities do not always exist in Europe therefore passengers must be able to negotiate steps and be able to walk several miles each touring day without assistance or difficulty.

It is each tour participant's responsibility to obtain the required travel documents. **U.S. citizens are required to have a valid passport for travel outside the US. The U.S. State Department requires that your passport be valid 6 months from the date of your return.** Also recommended is registration with the [Smart Traveler Enrollment Program](#).

Verify with your health insurance provider of coverage available while abroad. Take Me to Europe, LLC strongly recommends that you purchase travel insurance that will provide a peace of mind with your travel investment.

Take Me to Europe, LLC is responsible to you in making arrangements for the services offered in the package itinerary. The carriers, hotels and other suppliers providing package services are independent contractors and are not principals, agents, employees, partners, or joint ventures of Take Me to Europe, LLC. Concerning: Travel Insurance

Since Take Me to Europe does not sell travel insurance or gain any compensation from Travel Guard, you are welcome to explore other travel insurance companies.
